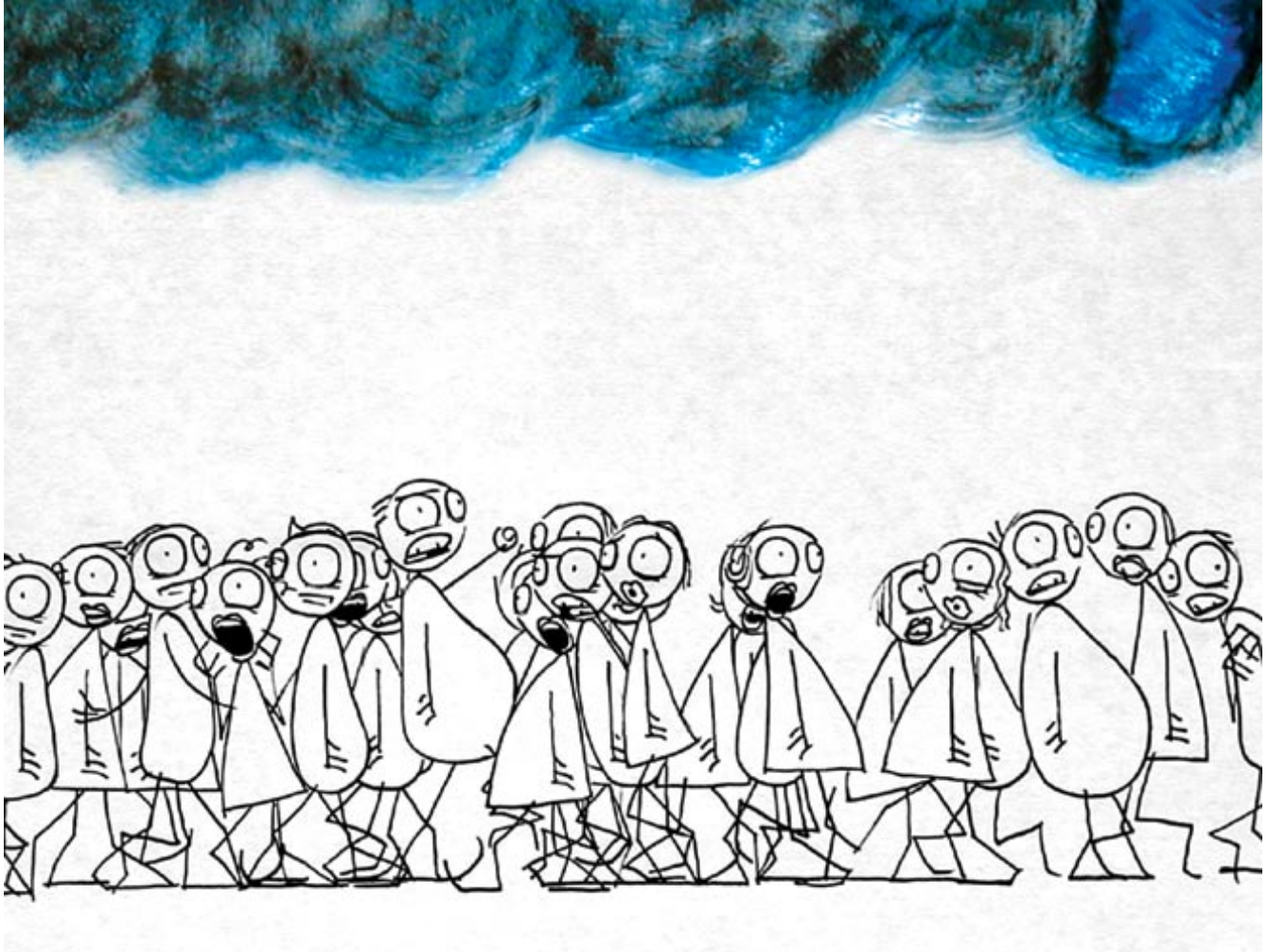


# Philosophy 160: Introduction to Ethics
